## **Physical Development -**

Paintbrush control - painting recognisable pictures.

Work on cutting skills in cutting area - vehicle cutting, cut roads/paths.

Manipulation of playdough to make vehicles.

Disco dough (x3 weekly)

Movement songs (x2 weekly)

Baking - weekly

Car wash - outdoor area

Moving soil using diggers

Building bridges for vehicles

#### **Communication and Language**

Circle time around emergency services - why do we need them? Who are they?

Introduce vehicle and travel vocabulary.

Weekly circle time - speaking in sentences.

Talk boost groups to begin.

Follow instructions using traffic lights and road sings.

Small world - vehicles

Vehicle description game. E.g. It is used on the water. It has a sail.

#### **Personal Social and Emotional**

Encourage children to work together in role play areas and develop narratives in their play.

Children to take turns when playing games (snap, jigsaws, bingo etc)

New starters - Adults to support children to settle into Nursery.

Adults to model play and behaviours in areas (PM Nursery).

Visits from emergency services

Emergency services role play

Aeroplane role play area

# **Transport**

#### <u>Literacy</u>

Read a variety of books relating to transport. Fiction - The train ride, Big Blue Train, Please don't chat to the bus driver, We all go travelling by.

Non-fiction - Amazing aeroplanes (full transport series), Things that go.

Encourage children to make their own books in writing area/ cutting area.

Phonics - follow Read Write Inc

Children to retell familiar stories using small world props.

Recognise and write name.

# **Expressive Arts and Design**

Design and build junk model vehicles

Vehicle colour sorting activity

Draw chalk roads for bikes and scooters in outdoor area.

Build vehicles using large construction materials.

Design and build a train tracks

Paint a variety of vehicles

Draw vehicles using the IWB

Digger dance - cbeebies

Transport songs: Wheels on the bus, Row your boat, A sailor went to sea, Twinkl transport songs.

## **Understanding of the World**

Children to draw vehicles on computer using 2simple

Make boats to sail in the water area. Explore floating and sinking.

Bee bots - directional/positional language

Sort vehicles in land, water and air.

Watch Grace's amazing vehicles (cbeebies)

Build ramps for cars - discuss faster/slower

Discuss which vehicles we use in our lives and which ones we don't. Explore reasons why. E.g. Why don't we come to school in a boat?

# Mathematics -

Sing number songs (5 little ducks, 5 current buns etc)
