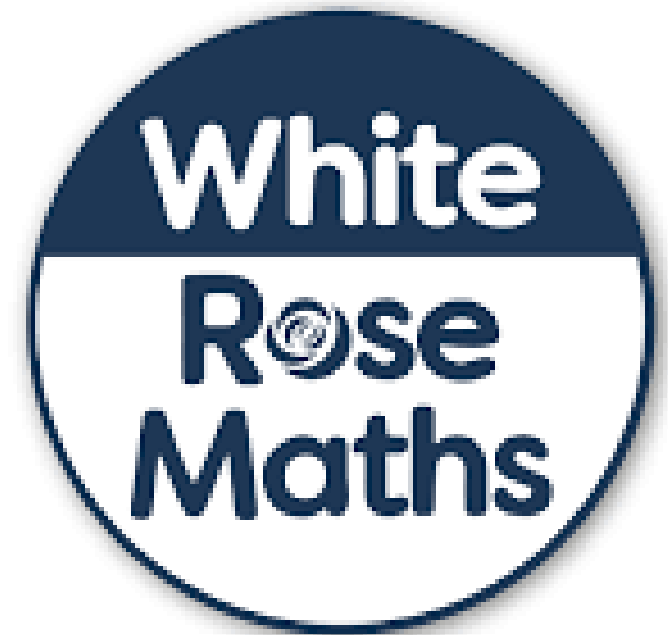
Accelerated Reader®



Phonics

Reading

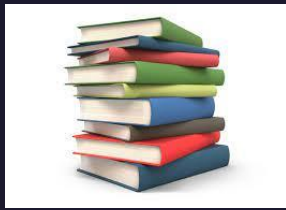
- Phonics – children need to read phonics books a minimum of 3 times before asking to change them. We ask you keep going with a book until they don't hesitate on any words so we improve their fluency.
- Accelerated Reader – children who have passed their phonics check will be given levelled books through the Accelerated Reader scheme. Children have completed an assessment, the results of which have provided school with a level for your child. Your child will have a book to keep in school and one to go home. Each time they finish a book, the log in and complete a quiz that assesses their comprehension. School can then identify any strengths or weaknesses in your child's reading abilities.



- We follow White Rose Maths scheme.
- Children work with concrete resources, build fluency and develop their reasoning skills.

We ask you support your child with learning their times tables (2s, 5s and 10s) in addition to the lessons we do in school. Purple Mash has lots of activities for this.

Homework



Each time your child reads to you at home it needs to be logged in your child's reading diary.

School will log how many times a week your child has read using the reading diary. This will be converted into raffle tickets (one ticket per entry) and children can win prizes each win. The more you read, the greater chance they will win.

Children will also receive certificates for how many books they have read. Chapters in longer books will be counted as an entire book to make it fair.



Homework



Spellings are in your child's homework folder. They are labelled week to week so you can see what they should know already and what is coming up. They are tested every Friday.

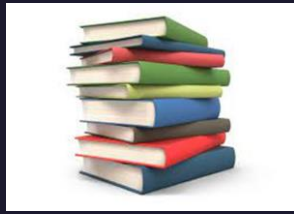
Phonics students: spelling sheets linked to your child's phonics level will be in their folder for completion weekly.

Maths homework will be linked to what we are doing in class or what is coming up to assess where children are in order to support with planning.

All homework should be handed in on a **Wednesday.**



Assessment



Children are continually assessed by the class teachers on Evidence Me.

SATS – throughout May 2023 (not statutory anymore but we will continue to do them in a relaxed way as they are a good assessment indicator as they progress).

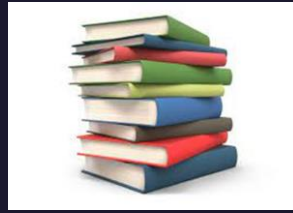
We create a stress-free environment in small groups where children can concentrate and do their best. No one needs to worry or do anything different during these periods.
